- Additional opportunities for planning and sponsorship outreach

Committee - Golf Tournament

- Golf Tournament held yearly in late Oct to early Nov
- Meet monthly for planning, 4 - 5 months before the tournament
- Help recruit sponsors, teams, and raffle items that can involve in-person visits and phone calls to companies
- Assist with setup the day before, 3-4 hours in the evening
- Participate the day of the tournament from 6 am to 3 pm

- Assist children in picking our books paid for by our club
